

# **CCHS Booster Club**

## **June 9, 2015 Meeting Minutes**

**The meeting was called to order by Lloyd Dixon at 7:00pm**

**Item 1: Athletic Director Report (Tom Salter)**

Tom provided a verbal report to the group. Dubois was confirmed as Assistant Principal over Discipline and Sports.

Attendance for the awards banquet was high. Athlete of the Year award was Elliot Stanger for boys, Taylor Selfridge for girls. Team of the Year for boys was Tennis. Girls Teams of the Year were Track and Cheer. There were 54 senior athletes with GPA's 3.5 or higher.

**Item 2: CCHS Administration Report (Dubois McMillan)**

Dubois expressed his appreciation to the CCHS members for their assistance with sports/clubs. He described the "Pursue Victory With Honor" and "Captains Council" programs that he has been involved with so far this year.

Coaches' training for character will be taking place June 30th, with athlete (shorter) training to occur shortly thereafter.

"A+A" program is for mentoring students who are struggling academically (2.0 GPA or lower). Student's teachers will be polled for their progress, and mentors will work with students on problem areas.

A general discussion ensued surrounding how team captains are chosen. The consensus was that most often the captains chosen exemplify leadership skills and character, not necessarily a senior player.

**Item 3: Treasurer's Report (Larry Zeidman)**

Larry provided a written report of the chart of accounts.

**Item 4: Approval of Minutes from May 2015 Meeting**

A copy of the minutes was distributed to the group. A motion was made to approve the minutes, which was seconded and unanimously approved.

**Item 5: Review of Funding for Referees and Tournaments (Tom Salter)**

Tom explained that funds are raised from various efforts (ASB cards, CCHS Boosters) to pay for referees and tournaments for the year. In previous years, a money market account was available to defray the costs. Tom intends to ask the district to help defray the costs, then devise a fundraising plan to compensate.

This year there is an estimated shortfall of approximately \$19,000.00, which is attributable to lower than average football and basketball gate sales and lower ASB card sales from the teams.

A general discussion ensued about possible solutions. Afterwards, Tom stated that he intends to meet with each coach/team to determine how they will be raising monies to offset the shortfall.

**Item 6: Announcements and Other Items**

Tom stated that last year the Boosters allotted \$2,000.00 for the Athletic Department budget. He asked for the Boosters to similarly allot this amount for this year's budget. A motion was made to this effect, which was seconded and approved unanimously.
