Since then, Mr. McMillan has accepted a position as Assistant Principal, but he still seems interested in working on this. Larry mentioned that the domain “cchsboosterclub.com” has been acquired, and will be used by the new site. Michael will follow up with McMillan next week.

Elizabeth reported that another \$300.00 membership was received.

George reported that he has been in contact with Bunnin Chevrolet, who is willing to have cars brought to CCMS for test drives. Tentative date for event would be Saturday, November 22nd between 10am and 3pm. George will confirm the dates with the dealer so that flyers can be made and distributed.

Lloyd mentioned that at last meeting it was discussed that teams should give wish lists for expenses. He will get with Tom to increase the feedback and report at next meeting.

Risa asked about whether other teams could sell items at the football games. Tom suggested that if Cross Country wanted to sell at a football game, the football coaches should be consulted. He is currently in discussions with the football coaches and cheerleading.
