Athletic Director: Jerry Chabola report fall season has started- football, boys water polo, girls tennis & volleyball, co-ed cross country and at the meet last week the athletes did well and times are improving, freshman volleyball tournament was Saturday, water polo season opened on 9/14/10, Coach Wright reported that freshman lost, J.V. won and varsity won 28-24, Coach Rothenberg report tennis team played first match last Saturday and lost, Transportation donation are about \$19,000.00 to date, parents who drive have to be cleared through fingerprints and T.B. test, this is a work in progress, Thanked B.C. for the supplying \$20,000.00, stated we're asking for donations for fall sports to be turned in by September 15 and all other sports by October 15, 2010, South Bay Athletic Association meeting is on 09/14/2010 and Jerry will attend, all fall sports coaches received the form to give out to all athletes on 09/14/2010 and requested that form be returned 09/15/2010 for the CCHS athletic donation, parents have options for payment like pay-pal, discuss 09/02/2010 parent meeting and the fact that we need more parent volunteers, stated we're not the same as LAUSD, fall sports schedules are on CCHS website now, total athletes at this time is about 400 and about 150 have paid their transportation donations, the sports forms will be required in the future to be turned in with the athletic packet which will be turned in personally by the athlete, and suggest that some personal call are made to parents regarding the donation.

Assistance Principal: Ian Drummond made request for Mr. Farris and asked for help with S.I. council and for all interested to e-mail him.
