Membership in the CCCC puts our club in a better position to work with the Chamber to support Booster Club activities and provides opportunity to coordinate and combine resources. The annual membership is \$150. The motion to approve Booster Club membership to the Culver City Chamber of Commerce for 2013 was made by Craig Singer. It was seconded by Lloyd Dixon.
